Council, on behalf of the residents of Dauphin request the federal government not to make any decisions about our public post office service until it has properly consulted with the public by holding public hearings across Canada.

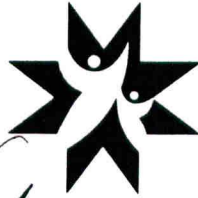
Please find attached a copy of Resolution #14, which the City of Dauphin Council passed at their Regular Meeting of July 14, 2008.
