WHEREAS the Canada Post Corporation Strategic Review, which was launched by the federal government on April 21, 2008, is looking at deregulating our public post offices; and,

WHEREAS it will become increasingly difficult for our public post office to provide affordable service to everyone, no matter where they live, if the government erodes or eliminates the very mechanism that funds universal postal services - the exclusive privilege; and,

WHEREAS postal deregulation in other countries has led to post office closures, less service, fewer jobs and higher postal rates for the public and small businesses; and,

WHEREAS the government is not holding public hearings as part of its strategic review or adequately consulting with the real owners of the post office - the public;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of The Corporation of The City of Dryden opposes the deregulation of Canada Post and insists that the government hold public hearings and properly consult with the true owner of Canada Post - the public; and,

THAT a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Prime Minister, Canada Post, Mr. Roger Valley, M.P. - Kenora District, and the Canadian Union of Postal Workers.
