Re: Canada Post Corporation Strategic Review.

I am writing to express my opposition to deregulating Canada Post service.

Breaking the Universal service provided by our profit making Canada Post Corporation does not make sense.

I have found that Conservative governments make decisions based on ideology and not on common sense. An example is the Ontario privatization of municipal water testing. Another example is the Ontario privatization of the Technical Standards and Safety Authority.
